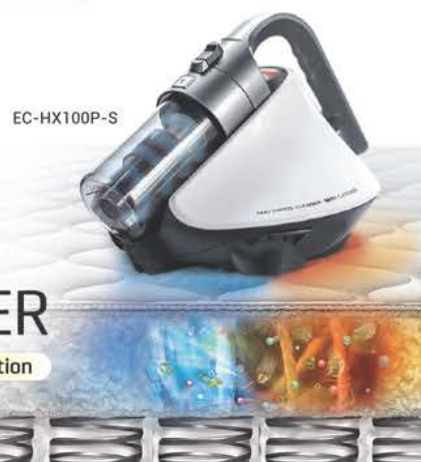

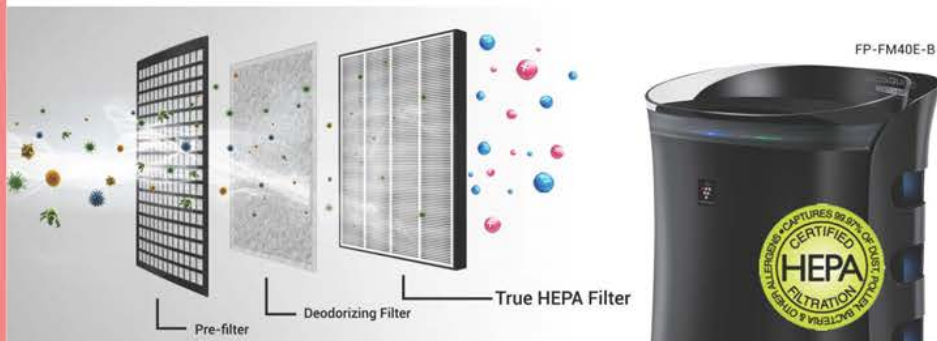

# Ayala Center: "A Labyrinth of Shops"

The Ayala Center is a commercial destination in Makati. It consists of several shopping malls such as Greenbelt, Glorietta, SM Makati and The Landmark. Navigation through these malls can be very easy because they are connected by underpasses or footbridges. Simply saying, this whole area is like a one big maze. The locations of these malls are very convenient too since it's near Ayala Avenue and MRT Ayala Station. Let's see what they have in this big shopping labyrinth!

## 1 Greenbelt

In here, beautiful lush gardens, high-end brand shops, and sophisticated restaurants await you.

The garden surrounded by Greenbelt 1 to 5 is an open rest area for shoppers. In the garden, people can stroll around and enjoy taking pictures of the relaxing place. They can also choose to feel the fine breeze while having great lunch by its outdoor dining areas.

This place is the most upscale mall in Ayala Center which accommodates other high-end shops. For a quick meal, you'll find some cheap restaurants in Greenbelt 1. Adults or kids, this place will surely be good for all ages.

## 2 Glorietta

Glorietta 1 to 4 opened in the 1990s while Glorietta 5 was established in the 2000s. This mall area displays a laidback and friendly ambience. It may also be the most popular among local shoppers. Glorietta is one of the largest shopping malls in the Ayala Center so they really got it all for you there. Since the area is relatively large, an area map might come in handy if you'll be a first time shopper here.

## 3 SM Makati

SM Malls is one of the top retail centers in the Philippines. It now holds more than 30 branches located in Metro Manila and other provinces in the country. In the basement floor of its Makati branch, there lies the supermarket along with an extended line of food and drinks selections. The department store called SM store is on the first floor up to the fifth floor.

You'll find a home center, toy shop, big fashion brands such as UNIQLO, FOREVER 21 and H&M. You can also find the famous international furniture store, Crate and Barrel at SM Makati Annex.

SM Makati is connected through MRT Ayala station and Glorietta.

### 7 Park Square



This is a 4-story parking building located right in front of SM Makati. You can see Family Mart and a Pizza restaurant called Project Pie in the first floor. Jeepney stop and UV express van going to South can also be found in the building.

### 8 The Link



This parking area is located just in front of Landmark. You'll see casual shops on the first floor such as electronic shop and restaurants.

### 9 6750 Office Tower Car Parks



This building is facing Ayala Avenue. On the first floor, high-class optical stores and jewelry stores can be found. You'll also find the famous salon Kérastase and a watch repair shop. There is also a popular steak house called La Cabrera.



## 4 The Landmark

This 4-floor department store provides a variety of products for locals' needs. It houses a large food court and supermarket in its basement. You'll find many grocery products available at reasonable prices here.

## 5 Rustan's

Rustan's is a luxury department store. The supermarket which is located on the first floor of this building has a variety of international foods from America and Europe. Their lineup of products is surely high-end and good in quality.

## 6 MRT Ayala Station

The MRT-Ayala station can be directly accessed from the third floor of SM Makati. In the station, there are kiosks for local eateries and fast food restaurants. There are also multiple bus stops under the station. Passengers can board these buses to and from main destinations such as Alabang.

#### 1 Between Greenbelt 4 and The Landmark



The bridge starts from the second floor of Greenbelt 4 next to The Body Shop, and it is connected to the second floor of The Landmark.

#### 2 Between The Landmark and Glorietta



This bridge starts from the second floor of The Landmark near a gadget store. This is the opposite side of Greenbelt's entrance. It is connected to the hallway between Glorietta 2 and 3.

#### 3 Between Glorietta and SM Makati



Starting from the hallway between Glorietta 1 and 4 on the third floor at the right next to True Value hardware store, this bridge ends at the second floor of SM Makati.

#### 4 Between SM Makati and MRT Ayala station



Starting from the third floor of SM Makati in front of Ace Hardware, is where MRT Ayala station is connected.

#### 5 Between Glorietta and Rustan's



All you need to do is go straight the hallway that starts between Glorietta 3 and 4, then you'll reach the entrance of Rustan's.

## Find everything you need for your daily life

Greenbelt 1 is the first retail complex opened by Ayala Group to the public. There is a variety of fast food, retail shops like home appliance center and gadget stores that you can visit here. Most stores in Greenbelt 1 provide products for one's daily necessities. It features appliance, stationery, mobile, and grocery products. It is conveniently located near Greenbelt 5.

■ There's a mini food bazaar happening in Greenbelt 1 every week. Vendors gather here from Wednesday through Friday to sell different local food products.



Every week from Wednesday through Friday, vendors set up their carts in front of Café Mediterranean. These carts will be filled with local delicacies such as snacks, spring rolls, nuts and fruits.

A Filipino traditional dessert called "suman" (sweet sticky rice wrapped in a banana leaf) is usually present on the cart, and it's worth a try! You wouldn't regret it because suman is one of the best treats in the Philippines. Good thing is that most of snacks are sold by weight.

### ■ Musical theatre - ONSTAGE



ONSTAGE is a live performance theatre located at the second floor next to the cinema houses. One of the popular shows they occasionally play here are musical plays based on Disney's famous classical fairytale stories. It provides casual yet enjoyable experience for all groups and families. ## SAKE-STEAMED CLAMS WITH CABBAGE AND SHIMEJI/BEECH MUSHROOM

Servings: 2

### INGREDIENTS

- 300g Fresh clams
- 50g Chopped cabbage
- 30g Shimeji/beech mushrooms
- 200ml Sake (Japanese rice wine)
- 5ml Soy sauce (KIKKO MAN)
- A dash of salt



Clams are one of the most harvested seafoods in the Philippines. There are different kinds of clams found off shore, such as blue colored, yellow-colored, and strange-patterned shells and more; but in the market, they are all combined and called "fresh halaa / clams or Asari". If you are in Metro Manila, you can find them at public markets like Carlinar, at prices ranging from P100 to P150 per kilo. Make sure the clams are alive, shells are firmly closed and are stored in clean water.

Clams are a good source of many nutrients, including iron and vitamin B12. These nutrients prevent anemia and maintains the nerve function. Also, they are high in taurine which lowers cholesterol levels, and has a good effect for both liver and brain.

Using fresh Philippine clams, you can create a delicious dish for your family dinner! Don't forget to clean it out and remove the salt and gunk.

1. Put water in a bowl and soak the clams to remove sand for 2 hours.

# Fortune Island

Believe it or not, 14 kilometers off the coast of Nasugbu is an island believed to have risen from the sea. It is named Fortune Island, a resort island that, due to mysterious reasons, was abandoned to rot. Now, it is considered to be an island of ruins, with structures reminiscent of the Parthenon in Ancient Greece. ## Scuba Diving & Hopping Tour

For an island hopping tour, the boat departs with a minimum fee of P1500 per person and a minimum number of five participants per group. Diving license is USD120 per person. Scuba diving and hopping tour raises the trip to Nasugbu a notch higher.

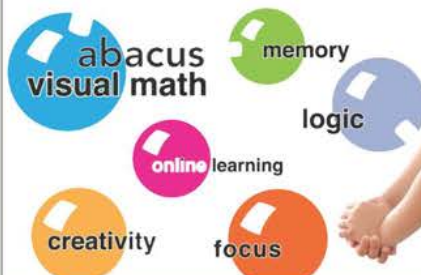

# Business Talk

An interview with the top executives in the Philippines

*Yokohama Tire Sales Philippines Inc. (YTSP) is a tire manufacturing facility located in Clark Freeport Zone, Angeles City, Pampanga. It produces 810,000 tires per month and exports all over the world.*

*Aside from importing materials, YTSP sells products made and produced in YTSP. Since Yokohama Tire has settled in the Philippines, high quality tires, which are described as Japanese quality, have been gradually recognized among Filipinos. Mr. Satoshi Hariyama, President of YTSP, says that offering high quality tires is very important to the safety of drivers.*

How did you start working for Yokohama Tire?

I didn't have any vision of my future when I was in school since baseball was my first priority. I am not sure but somehow I was hired by strange chance. I am really grateful to have this job.

How is Yokohama Tire doing in the Philippines?

The plant in Clark, Pampanga has a capacity of 44.7 hectares and 3,000 employees. This is our second largest facility in the world. It is recognized as one of the plants that contribute to the boost of the Philippine economy. Our tires have been used by many Japanese automobile manufacturers in the Philippines. When it comes to tire replacement the car owners choose our tires over others. Customers, who repeatedly choose our brand are a big advantage on our sales. I assume that the share of our products in the Philippines is approximately 20%.

We have many rivals who sell tires at reasonable prices, but we sell higher quality products in wide variety. For a long time now, we have been establishing good relationships among Filipino customers and are continuing to build up a reliable standard for our customers.

Tell us your company's product line-up distributed in the Philippines.

Our main products are the Blue Earth and Geolandar. The A-300 tires are used for brand new cars; this product also has very good sales.

What are the merits in having a facility in the Philippines?

The Philippines is experiencing rapid economic growth and new car sales are increasing in recent years. It is expected that this economic boom will continue until year 2020 or so. So, we are sure that we are going to have more opportunities to expand the market in the Philippines. We continuously try to work hard when it comes to taking business in our hands.

What is the sales strategy of Yokohama Tire in the Philippines?

In the Philippines, our products are being sold through distributors. We are trying to have more retail shops that can distribute our products with enough capacity of demands.

Also, we have newly launched tire products for trucks. Hopefully, these will get retailers' attention. I recognize that expanding both the affiliated retailers and product items are essential to increase the volume of sales.

In the 2015-2016 season, Yokohama Tire has been sponsoring an elite soccer team in England called Chelsea Football Club. Do you think it is effective?

As you know, soccer is not a popular sport in the Philippines. So the interest for soccer is not high. I am hoping that my interview will be a good promotion for Primer readers to be aware of the company and the products.

On the other hand, basketball in the Philippines is considered to be a national sport. Yokohama Tire just made a sponsor contract with PBA (Philippine Basketball Association). We are still trying to figure out how to improve the awareness of Filipinos to our products. Hopefully, these sponsorships for both soccer and basketball will be a good promotion for the company.

Do you have any conflicts in doing business in the Philippines? If so, how did you handle these?

I understand that the prices of tires could be the first priority when it comes to purchasing tires, because a tire itself is an expensive product. I see many new venture companies who are not from Japan offering cheaper tires and that could be one of the conflicts.

Safety and reliability of products are our main concerns. We hope that the consumers will be aware of how reliable and safe our tires are which are all labeled as Japan quality. We can proudly say that we have been offering one of the safest tires in the world. All of our tires cannot be on the market if they don't pass our strict safety test.

If you need to replace tires for your car, please check Yokohama brand first.

Why do you think that the tires from Yokohama Tire have better reliability than other companies'?

The roads in the Philippines have severe condition for tires, such as high temperatures, heavy rain, and occasional "stop & go" especially on the city roads. Drivers may encounter a lot of risks when their tires wear down fast or even burst. Though rubbers are prone to deterioration and thermal cracking, we have been making tires that are suited for Philippine roads that can also overcome the changing climate.

If a tire bursts while driving, a serious accident will occur. I am not saying that all cheap tires are bad quality, but when you choose tires for your car, you should not solely focus on the price. Quality and reliability should be the first thought for your safety.

What is the advantage of having Filipino staff?

I have visited our overseas facilities such as in U.S.A., Canada, China and many European countries so far. I saw a lot of Filipinos working in most of the facilities abroad. Speaking from my experience, Filipinos have the ability to communicate in different languages. Some Filipino employees are able to speak English and Japanese other than Tagalog. Also, they are so friendly and generous. I think that it is easy to establish a relationship with Filipino staff, especially if you treat them as family.

Do you have pieces of advice for Japanese people who work overseas like you?

The Japanese marketing-style also known as the "relationship marketing," works here. Since it is a Japanese system, I thought it only works for Japanese companies in Japan. But somehow, it is not as bad to use it here as I previously thought.

It doesn't matter where you are; you have to build up good relationship with your clients or customers. Once you get to know each other and build a relationship, it is easier to deliver on what they expect.

Looking around our facility, I think I need to teach this proposal skill to the Filipino employees because they are still unfamiliar to the Japanese marketing-style.

On the other hand, I am learning many things from the local employees, such as the hospitality skill. It is a good opportunity to learn some strength from each other.

How do you spend your free days?

I play golf, jog on treadmill, or watch a movie in cinemas. For movies, I need subtitles in Japanese when I watch. I wish Filipino movie theaters would have it.

What is your dream? What is your future outlook?

I'd like to promote Yokohama Tire in any way I can. What I am experiencing now will be a good foothold to success. I truly enjoy living and working here. I appreciate the situation that I am in now because the chance of living overseas is not for everybody. This experience will surely will be the sum of my future.

For my personal wish, I would like to take a trip to many other countries with my family.

Satoshi Hariyama was born in Fukuoka and spent his early days in Amagasaki, Japan. After he graduated from high school in Nagoya, he moved to Tokyo for his college education.

Since then, he has been going back and forth between the sales office and the main company every three or four years. He dedicated himself to the Domestic Sales Division.
