NAGANO

ADVENTURE CONTINUES...

There are a lot of reasons why Nagano is becoming a popular destination in Japan. It's more than just a prefecture with an efficient transportation system, safe environment, and kind locals. With its remarkable cultural sites, fun outdoor activities, and delicious local food, Nagano can surely make any visitor fall in love with it the second time around.

Last issue, we introduced you to Nagano's snow monkeys, the best spots in Karuizawa, the temples in Nagano City, and the food stops in Matsumoto. In this second part of our Nagano special, get to know more about the southern part of Nagano — starting with Matsumoto, a modern city with a deep respect for tradition in a maze of contemporary structures and rich historic sites.



Matsumoto Castle

"Outstanding" would be a word that would best describe Matsumoto Castle. One of Nagano's prominent tourist spots, it was built between 1593 and 1594. It was declared as a national treasure and was carefully restored and preserved for a long time. It's known as the "Crow Castle" because of its black structure, which is made of wood and plaster. It rests on top of a stone base and is surrounded by a crystal clear moat that, if you stand on the right spot outside, you can see the castle's reflection. During the cherry blossom season, the structure creates a beautiful contrast with pink hues. This 400-year-old fortress has stood the test of time. To get inside, we passed by two gates, with the second gate positioned on the right angle. The gates are enclosed by defense walls with tiny holes for shooting bullets and arrows. This type of gate is called masugata, a kind of trap entrance for intruders.

At the entrance of the main castle, we were asked to remove our shoes and wear the slippers provided. This is a common Japanese tradition.

We started the tour by checking out the Gun Museum on the second floor. This is where all kinds of weaponry are displayed – from the smallest to the largest guns, to self-defense guns, matchlocks, and armors equipped with battle accessories.

The enormous castle appears to be five storeys high, when in fact, there are 6 floors inside. The actual third floor is not visible from the outside. This is called the "hidden floor" which served as the castle's safe room where there are no windows.

The stairs between the fourth and fifth floors are the steepest in the castle, with each step measuring about 40 centimeters, while the top floor was the castle's watch tower. This floor is covered with 16 pieces of *tatami* (woven floor). Climbing the steep stairs of Matsumoto castle is worth the trip because you get to see a magnificent view from the top floor: the entire city of Matsumoto.

Matsumoto Castle is open from 8:30 am – 5:00 pm. Entrance fee is ¥610.

Street Food in Nawate Street

While walking in the street of Nawate, get some *taiyaki*, a fish-shaped pastry filled with red bean paste (¥230). You can also score some fresh fruits, traditional crafts, and pottery items here.



Nakamachi Street

Nakamachi Street is the town center of Matsumoto City. Parallel to Nawate Street, it is also just a few minutes walk from the castle. Some of the houses used to be a warehouse and were designed to be fireproof as seen on the black and white checker layer on the bottom half part of the buildings.



Matsumoto Catholic Church

If you are a Catholic and you see yourself in Matsumoto, stop by at Matsumoto Catholic Church in front of Matsumoto castle. Surprisingly, there's a number of Filipinos who attend mass here because some of the pamphlets written in Filipino language are available inside. The church holds mass from 7am and 10am every Sunday.



Special Feature: Nagano, Japan

Nature at full speed. Hakuba's powdery snow makes its slopes great for advanced skiers and snowboarders in Japan. Home of the 1998 Winter Olympics, Hakuba is one of East Asia's largest ski resorts. It encompasses 10 ski resorts, comprising the Hakuba Valley. The village may only have 9,000 residents, but Hakuba attracts 3 million tourists every year because of its famous powdery snow. Hakuba is easy to get to from Tokyo and Osaka. If you are coming from Nagano City, you can take the bus at the back of Nagano Station for ¥1800 one way.



Hakuba Lion Adventure

Hakuba Lion Adventure is an outdoor activity company in Hakuba that offers white water rafting, canoeing, hot air balloon rides, and snowmobiling. Hakuba Lion Adventure also operates a café and rental shop for those who need a complete set of gear during the tour. Our day in Hakuba started in Lion Café, where we met the Hakuba Lion Adventure team who guided us through the day. We were given information about Hakuba and discussed safety precautions during the tour. After the introduction, we headed to the Rainbow Rental shop to dress ourselves with snow gear and collected our snowmobile equipment.

The guides made sure we felt safe and had a good time during the snow mobile activity. Our team navigated our *Ski-doo* at the riverside of Hakuba 47 Winter Sports Park. Our tour guide, Yu, was very patient and really paid attention to us. Together with his co-instructor, Shelley, they made sure to stay close in case we got stuck in the snow. The snowmobiles are easy to master as long as you are careful. Flying through fluffy powder snow with the Northern Alps as background was an exhilarating experience.

The snow mobile tour can run from 30 minutes to 1 hour. Make sure you check the weather and reserve in advance since the snow mobile tour can be cancelled due to lack of snow. If snow mobile is not available, tourists can experience other activities, such as a hot air balloon ride, mountain bike tour, paragliding, or white water rafting. The company is composed of different nationalities to make each tour as comfortable as possible to non-Japanese guests. Hakuba Lion Adventure can also pick you up from your hotel to the ski resorts.

One of the most popular ski resorts in the area is Hakuba 47. The name comes from the idea of "4 seasons, 7 days a week." The resort offers a variety of terrain for different types of skiers. This, along with the quality of their snow, sets Hakuba 47 apart from other resorts in Hakuba Valley.



There are plenty of lifts to take you on top of the mountain. You get excellent views of Hakuba once you go up the gondola. The lift will take five minutes to reach the top of the mountain. There's also an available restaurant, toilet, and souvenir shops for people who would like to take a break from the cold.





For beginners, the resort offers ski and snowboard lessons in English which is quite convenient. It's a great place for a beginner to experience the slopes. Don't worry if you are not good on your first try. Remember: we were all beginners to the sport once, so go ahead and ski away! Like majority of Filipinos, we are not used to the cold weather, so to be setting off in a ski board at below zero temperature was not something we expected to particularly enjoy. Wrapped up in a gear we can barely walk in, we went out of our comfort zone and learned how to ski.

HA MANAGARA

Learning how to ski takes patience and dedication. Luckily, our guide has the patience of a great teacher. We were really glad we tried it in Hakuba, and while it was as much of a mental challenge as it was a physical one, I'm sure I'll give it another go when I go back to Hakuba.



Hakuba 47 is a few kilometers by road from the Hakuba train station and 5 kilometers from Happo, the main tourist hub of Hakuba Valley. It is open from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Conveniently located at the center of Hakuba Village, Brownie Cottages & Condominiums is the perfect accommodation whilst skiing in Hakuba. Owned by a Japanese man and his Filipina wife, Brownie is like your home away from home. The cottages are just a short stroll from Echoland Main Street where the bars and shops are located. The rooms inside are spacious and the beds are very comfortable. The kitchen is well-equipped with dishes and cutlery. Other amenities like drying storage and Wi-Fi are also available inside the cottage.

Guests can choose to stay in a cozy wooden cottage or a Japanese-style apartment which both offer nature and mountain views. We recommend booking a transfer from the train or bus station to the resort. They also provide shuttle to and from the slopes. Mr. Shinji Wada, the owner, went above and beyond and was very accommodating to show us around town.

Our team had dinner at a private *teppanya-ki* restaurant called Sarugaku. The *teppanyaki* room can only hold up to 6 people, hence their priority on those with reservations. If you are looking for a fun dinner, then Sarugaku is the best choice. We enjoyed the high quality Japanese-style fresh beef and fried rice risotto prepared at our table by the expert chef.













Immerse yourself by learning how wasabi is cultivated, from planting to harvesting. Wasabi is a very important product of Japan, whose demand has increased significantly throughout the years. The lovely early autumn morning had us making our way to visit Daio Wasabi Farm that is located in the outskirts of Matsumoto.

Daio Wasabi Farm is one of the largest wasabi farms in Japan. Here, we were welcomed by the wasabi master himself, Mr. Hama. Daio Wasabi Farm is like a park complete with restaurants, shrines, and souvenir shops that sell wasabi-related products.

We first explored Daio Shrine where the ancient local hero, Hachimen Daio is revered. We also visited the location of the Hollywood movie "Dreams", directed by Akira Kurosawa.



The majestic view of the two lakes and watermill only added to the beauty of the place. Our team headed to the farm proper to observe the process of growing wasabi. We learned that there are two different kinds of wasabi: the horse radish and the hon wasabi, which are mainly grown here in Daio Wasabi Farm. It is also considered as the 'real' wasabi. Mr. Hama told us that wasabi can only be grown in clean running water and will take one and a half years to grow. The root and rhizomes of wasabi contains the most flavor and nutrients. The rhizomes should be grinded to extract wasabi's fresh, sharp, and sweet flavor.

The trip to Daio Wasabi Farm not only helped us educate ourselves with the origin of wasabi, but also appreciate and respect the people who painstakingly grow the product.

To go there, take the JR train from Matsumoto station to Hotaka station (about 30 minutes), then grab a taxi to the wasabi farm (about 10 minutes). To go back, ask the staff to hail a taxi. Entrance is free of charge.



Our day ended at the ALPS Azumino National Government Park to watch the illumination display. It is a popular destination for amazing illumination displays during winter with over 70,000 light bulbs that flicker in time with music. Luckily, our team had the chance to watch the installation last January. The park's theme then was the four seasons of Japan. Each area had its own design: cherry blossom lights for spring; Christmas tree lights for winter; and flowers for summer. If you want to see this sparkling creation, make sure to include Azumino's illumination park in your Nagano itinerary. The illumination display is available from November to early January. The park opens at 9:30 am and closes at 9:00 pm (illumination begins from 4:00 pm).

GISHODO SUWAKO WATCH & CLOCK MUSEUM

Suwa is known as the origin of watch-making in Japan. On our first day in Suwa, we visited Gishodo, a unique museum for clocks. The museum features a novelty shop and a fascinating exhibit room filled with old wall clocks. The museum also offers clock-making lessons. Our clock-making prowess was tested when they asked us to make one for ourselves, with the help of the staff, of course. It was a fun experience that you wouldn't want to miss. Outside the museum is the water-operated astronomical clock tower known as Suiun-Gishodai. The big clock is a replica of the one constructed in China.











We enjoyed the peaceful atmosphere of each shrine and saw the lumber being used for the Onbashira festival, a ritual held every six years wherein Japanese people ride tree logs which slide down the slope. Make your visit in Suwa a memorable one by paying respect in one of these shrines.

We made our way to the Suwa Garasunosato Museum on our last day in Suwa. Garasunosato is a glass museum that displays glass pieces by famous glasswork artists of Suwa. The museum showcases 20,000 pieces of glass products. Some of the pieces here change with the seasons but there are permanent displays as well. Guests can experience making glass candles, seals, beads, and paperweights. A few minutes away from the glass museum is the strawberry farm where we had the sweetest strawberries we've ever tasted. The farm offers a 30-minute strawberry picking experience in which visitors may pick and eat as many strawberries as they like.

Kazuhiro Ishida General Manager of Japan Airlines (JAL) in the Philippines

Kazuhiro Ishida is the General Manager of Japan Airlines (JAL) in the Philippines, Before being assigned to the country, he worked in China as part of JAL's marketing team for four years

How long have you been the General Manager for JAL Philippines?

I've been General Manager for JAL for three years and 6 months. I was transferred from Tokyo after being a temporary member of the Olympic Bid Committee. An interesting thing happened while I was part of the bid committee. During the ceremony in Buenos Aires, the person who delivered the envelope to the International Olympic Committee chairperson was a Filipino, [Francisco] Elizalde. Perhaps it was a sign for me to go to the Philippines.

How has JAL done in the Philippines in terms of passenger departures? Do Filipinos choose JAL to fly to Japan?

Our main customers right now are Filipinos. A few years ago, however, we catered more to Japanese businessmen and Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) flying between Manila and Tokyo. We also have the Filipino leisure market flying to America, especially to the West Coast. However, we shifted to catering more to tourists after the significant increase of Filipino tourists [who fly to Japan].

What has been the biggest hurdle JAL has faced in the Philippines?

We have had problems with infrastructure, but the situation has greatly improved compared to previous years. The completion of the Skyway (NAIAX) and renovations to NAIA Terminal 1 have helped out a lot. Transportation Secretary [Arthur] Tugade knows the situation of the airline industry, and his efforts have helped improve it.

What has been some of the biggest contributions of JAL to the Philippines?

US occupied Japan back in 1951. JAL was not given a permit to self-operate by the US, but Philippine Airlines (PAL) was kind enough to loan their aircraft to JAL under the condition that they keep an image of the Philippine flag on the plane. In many aspects, PAL taught JAL how to operate as an airline.

1967 saw the maiden voyage of our Japan-Manila flights, so we have a lot of shared history. JAL has helped the country since then.

When Super Typhoon Yolanda hit the Philippines in 2013, the Japanese Government dispatched the Japan Disaster Relief (JDR) Medical team with the help of chartered flights from JAL, all within of 24 hours. In total, the JDR took two JAL charter flights and a regular flight to help in the relief efforts for Typhoon Yolanda.

JAL also sends one Filipino each year to Japan via the JAL Scholarship Program. A total of 1,471 students have participated in the program since it was launched in 1975, with many of the alumni now playing an active role in the international community.

JAL has also given several provinces access to solar lights, thanks to its Charity Mile Project and our partnership with Kopernik, a Japanese non-profit organization that helps address social issues in developing countries. Customers can choose to donate their miles to the project to aid in making solar lights for provinces like Negros.

How has it working with the Filipino staff here

It's enjoyable for me [to work with Filipino staff]. You see, 70 percent of seamen employed by Japanese-owned shipping companies are Filipino because they are adaptable and generous wherever they are. My Filipino staff share the same talent, and I appreciate their adaptability.

How many flights do JAL operate in the Philippines? Does JAL plan to fly out of Clark or

JAL currently operates two flights between Narita Airport and NAIA. Right now, we do not have any plans of expanding our flights to Clark or Cebu, but we do plan to add more flights due to an increase in tourists.

We do, however, provide other options for those who want to fly to Japan. Jetstar Japan, our subsidiary low-cost carrier, operates daily flights from Narita, three flights a week from Osaka (Kansai), and four flights a week from Nagoya. The casual service they provide cater more to the younger generation, while JAL's full-service flights cater more to businessmen and those passengers who prefer flying with a full-service airline.

How would you describe the way you manage

It's very difficult, but I would like to use the Rio Olympics as a comparison, in particular the 400-meter men's relay. Japan came in second that time, with Jamaica winning gold and the US winning bronze. Some of our athletes were talented, but they were not as strong compared to those from the US or Jamaica individually. However, if they focus their energies and cooperate together as a team, they can beat the US.

The Filipino staff here already have a good relationship with each other, and I would like to strengthen that bond through teamwork.

Who is the person you look up to in JAL?

I look up to Dr. Kazuo Inamori, the former chairman of JAL and the founder of Kyocera and KDDI. He became JAL's chairman after the company filed for bankruptcy.

He made dramatic changes as JAL's chairman [to improve the company]. He was a very modest man who refused the salary he was being given. He essentially worked as a volunteer for JAL.

He was a rich yet modest man, often making reservations in small hotels. Everyone in JAL looks up to Dr. Inamori because of this.

Describe your typical day at work.

Every week I attend to the airport. I greet VIP passengers at the check-in counter. It's fun to talk to the customers. That's why I work even during weekends. In the office, I usually talk to our Passenger Sales Manager about sales planning and our target market.

We do not have private rooms here at JAL, same as the JAL headquarters. If you want to talk to the president, you can do so without having to schedule a meeting with a secretary. I'm also active with promoting Japan to Filipino tourists by talking to tourism organizations in

What quote or phrase motivates you to do well in your job?

The enterprise is a difficult one, but 'when there is a will there is a way;' and what colonization needs most is a hearty will. -Abraham Lincoln, 1857.

When I was a part of the Olympic Bid Committee, everyone did not think that Tokyo will get to host the 2022 Games. There's the radiation issue, the competition like Turkey and Spain, and the fact that Tokyo is quite far from Europe and the United States.

Japan, however, has experience in hosting the Games since we have hosted the [Summer and Winter] Olympics a total of four times. We had to resolve the radiation concerns and have the entire team be in one mind in wanting to host the Games.

What are your plans for JAL in the Philippines?

I would like to increase our number of flights. The number of Filipino tourists flying to Japan has steadily increased over the years, and I would like to take advantage of that by adding more flights.

As you know, JAL is a very modest organization. We mostly employ Japanese staff, but now we've changed our strategy. We would now like to send foreign staff to other areas. Filipinos are the best candidate because they can speak English fluently and are very adaptable.

The airport staff you see in Dubai and Singapore are mostly Filipinos, that's why I would like to send Filipino staff to our offices in other countries.


