SILANG

Many beautiful places in Silang have often been mistakenly associated with Tagaytay. Perhaps the confusion is due to the fact that these two close neighbors have very similar features. Silang has a cool, comfortable climate. The town sits on high terrains—which keeps it safe from floods. And it is covered by a lot of greenery—forests, farms, gardens.

Despite these similarities to Tagaytay, Silang has its own charm, a beauty that has long been kept below the radar. Although in recent years Silang has opened up to more industrial and commercial developments, its true characteristics remain embedded on the local businesses. Silang is home to many garden restaurants, farms, and off-the-beaten-track galleries that showcase local talent, making it a perfect destination to reconnect with nature and meet passionate people. These components are what's pushing its beauty slowly to the surface.





To get to know a town to its core, you must visit its local market. Silang Public Market, just a five-minute walk from the town plaza, is a one-stop destination to get the best of Cavite's primary produce like pineapple, coconut, coffee, and vinegar.

The market is open every day, but you can find it in full buzz on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays, when various products are brought fresh to the market. Helpful locals will also gladly help you in case you are in need of directions and information around the place.

If you go out to the highway from the market and drive or walk south, you will quickly find a beautiful, refreshing scenery of green canopies, and rows of plants and flowers that are up for sale. This section of Emilio Aguinaldo Highway is also called Bypass Road by locals and probably the most beautiful part of the drive of anyone headed to Silang or further south.

There is a huge assortment of plants: garden plants, indoor plants, hanging plants, orchids, flowers, cacti, bonsai, fern, and a whole lot more. You can buy small plants and orchids for as low as P50. The shops also offer landscaping services and garden decoration.

Meanwhile, if you drive on Sta. Rosa-Tagaytay Road on the eastern side of Silang, you will find another distinct string of shops that represent local industry—furniture and woodworking. Most of the furniture are made of wood, while others are made of local materials like rattan. If you find pieces that would suit your home, you can buy and get them delivered to your doorstep at reasonable prices.

Getting to Silang

It takes about 1 to 2 hours from Manila to Silang, Cavite.

By car

Take Emilio Aguinaldo Highway via Cavitex if you are going to downtown Silang, where most of the major establishments are located.

If you are coming from Nuvali or Santa Rosa Laguna, you can take the Santa Rosa-Tagaytay Road and either go around Tagaytay or take Pooc Road in Barangay Lumil to reach the town proper.

By public transport

Bus: Erjohn and Almark from Ayala Makati or Pasay / buses bound for Tagaytay, Mendez, or Nasugbu (get off on Emilio Aguinaldo Highway)

P2P: Trasierra St., Legaspi Village, Makati (near Corinthian Carpark) ←→ Robinsons Place Dasmariñas (P150); take a jeepney or bus to Silang

Getting around Silang

Within downtown Silang and along Bypass Road, the main mode of public transport is tricycle. For establishments farther from the town proper, you can take the jeepney or bus.

With the vision of becoming one of Asia's outstanding golf courses, the Riviera Golf Club in Silang is nothing short of spectacular. The landscape of the golf club is ideal for golfers of varying skills and ages. It also provides comfort and elegance in playing the sport. Riviera welcomes non-members (subject for approval by reservation). It is advised to book nine days before your desired date. Rates for non-members are P3,300 on weekdays and P4,300 on weekends, plus a P350 consumable fee and P170 insurance. They adopt a passport system, so payments are usually done after the game. Non-members who are going in with members may get discounted rates. A game for members is only P60.

Gourmet Farms is a 12-hectare estate, home to a vast plantation of lettuce. Founded by Ernest Escaler in the early 1980s, Gourmet Farms began as a coffee trading company with a vision to share Philippine beans with the worldwide market and import beans from around the world for Filipinos to try them.

If you dine at The Dining Room, the farm-to-table restaurant of Gourmet Farms, you can experience a farm tour for free. After your meal of fresh salad, pasta and pizza, your walking tour starts at the lettuce plantation with greenhouses for herbs like basil and dill. You may also come across friendly farm animals.

You may also get a glimpse of St. Joseph's Sanctuary, a retreat house hidden by trees, which give it an air of seclusion and serenity. With 10 guest rooms and a conference room, it is usually a venue for company retreats.

The last stop is the state-of-the-art coffee roastery where they store green coffee beans as well as some imported beans from Brazil and other coffee-producing countries.

Cap off the tour with The Dining Room's Signature Cooler, made with basil and lemon, or a cup of coffee at Gourmet Cafe, where you can sample the farm's best brews or shop pasalubong (souvenirs).

Tours are held from Monday to Friday, at 10 am, 1 pm, and 3 pm. It is advised to book 7 business days in advance.


Within its six hectares of land, you are guaranteed to find beautifully landscaped natural and man-made features such as the lake and the hanging bridge, surrounded by adorable farm animals like goats, ostriches, turkeys, Asian palm civets, and more.

The resort also has educational farm facilities where guests can try planting and farming. There are also more challenging physical activities such as obstacle courses (P225/head; minimum of 5 pax), ATV (P150/30 mins.), a zip line (P200/zip; minimum of 3 pax), and trekking by the river (P170; minimum of 5 pax). If one day isn't enough—which most likely it isn't—Gratchi's Getaway has nipa hut-inspired lodgings that can cater to small and large groups. Room rates range from P2,500 to P13,500.

Public transportation is limited where Gratchi's Getaway is located, so it is best to bring a private vehicle. Otherwise, you may take a tricycle from Tagaytay Central Terminal for P200. When leaving, the resort staff can call a tricycle for you.

The rolls are stuffed manually-shredded with vegetables like cabbage, carrots, and lettuce, along with tofu, shrimp, and ground pork. It is then drizzled with their special secret sauce. Amoy Lumpia is served in big sizes to ensure that you eat your money's worth.

Aside from the spring rolls, the cafe's menu also consists of Filipino favorites like Kare-Kare and Palabok, and dishes from American and Chinese cuisines to cater to their growing expat diners.

Among their most sought-after dishes is the Chicken Salsa Verde, made with pan-grilled chicken with a zesty salsa verde sauce and served with turmeric rice and mixed green salad. For a more dynamic meal, try the Nasi Goreng, another best seller made with chicken and pork barbeque with peanut sauce served on top of fried rice with crunchy prawn crackers on the side.

Business Talk

An interview with the top executives in the Philippines Get a first person point of view when it comes to business



Hubert Young is the CEO of UCC Ueshima Coffee Philippines, Inc., established as a joint venture with the UCC Ueshima Coffee Company (Japan) in 2014. With an experience in the food industry spanning over three decades, Hubert Young is highly reputed among Japanese restaurant industry players. With an affinity for Japan and a deep understanding of the local market, he has successfully brought popular brands to the Philippines, including UCC, Mitsuyado Sei-Men, Coco Ichibanya, Yamato Bakery Cafe, Tendon Kohaku, Shaburi and Kintan Buffet, and, the latest, Mos Burger.

Please tell us about yourself, your background and experience.

I am more of an entrepreneur; I take more challenges than the normal person. I come from a food manufacturing business, to start with. My family owns a very old company in the Philippines, which has evolved into a flour milling company called General Milling Corp. Back then, I was running the coffee manufacturing facility back in 1985-86. At that time, our company had the franchise for Hills Bros. Coffee, which was based in San Francisco. I worked in San Francisco for several years and trained as a coffee person. When the Philippines had a revolution in 1986, I had to go back to the US and stay there for a while. I came back in 1993; I went into other businesses until I went to search for UCC.

Can you tell us about UCC Ueshima Coffee Philippines, Inc.?

Back then, everyone in the Philippines was leaning towards American brands. You had California Pizza Kitchen, TGIFridays, Chili's; everybody had the American mentality. I didn't want to be like them so I decided to go Asian. When traveling in Asia, we always went to UCC for coffee in Hong Kong and bought UCC products in the supermarket; so I had a dream that maybe I should bring UCC to the Philippines.

I looked at the packaging of UCC and everything

was in Japanese. So I thought, what is the best way to get Filipinos to understand the product? As a Filipino, I know that Filipinos love to eat, Filipinos love to socialize. They used to go to hotel lobbies for business and coffee. Back then, coffee at a hotel was P120. If people were paying for this, I said maybe I should put up a coffee shop as a vehicle to introduce the brand, UCC. I decided that the coffee shop should be a place where people can come in and have their business just like in a hotel, enjoy good coffee and good food. My problem then was that UCC coffee was expensive compared to other coffee shops and QSRs (quick-service restaurants). So, I had to think of the best food cost where I could throw in the coffee for free to let the Filipinos try it.

Again, I wanted to be different so I said, no espresso, only syphon—because there was no competition with syphon. We put the syphon brewing in the middle of the bar so people could see and be intrigued with this new method. To me, that was my show and tell.

How did you bring other Japanese franchises to the Philippines?

Fast forward to 2011-12, when ramen was just about to become popular, we started Mitsuyado Sei-Men in Jupiter, Makati, but instead of ramen, we specialized in tsukemen. Ramen is noodle, tsukemen is noodle, but they are very different; just like how syphon is different from espresso.

In 2014, we went into a joint venture with UCC in the coffee manufacturing business. This business partnership led to other opportunities and got us Coco Ichibanya in 2015. What else do I want to do in the Philippines? Filipinos love to eat tempura, so we searched around and saw this tempura shop in Singapore doing very well: Tendon Kohaku. Now, we have 2 stores but we are opening our third and fourth in the next few months.

It kept coming—and the latest is Shaburi Kintan,

which was in the works about a year ago. Mr. Eiji Kamada (Dining Innovation CEO) came and asked if we wanted to handle a shabu-shabu and yakiniku brand, the Japanese way. We struck an alliance, so we now hold the master franchise for Dining Innovation in the Philippines.

What was my real dream in 1998-99? I met with Mr. Atsushi Sakurada (Mos Burger Chairman), and I told him I have always dreamt of Mos Burger since 1998 but never had the chance. On June 4, 2019, we signed a contract for a joint venture. We are not only forming a joint venture to manage and grow retail shops but we are also doing a joint venture for a new central kitchen for Mos Burger, which will hopefully take place sometime this year and the store early next year.

What are the challenges you have encountered in running the company and how did you deal with them?

Dealing with retail is the hardest business. It has taught us to be more patient and understanding of our customers. Furthermore, as you are aware, the retail market always evolves and we have to always be one step ahead.

Have you ever considered coming up with your own business?

Because I'm a marketing person, branding is important. Having the credentials and helping the Japanese expand in this country is my forte, and that is where I'll stick. I may not own the brand but I love the brand, and I run the business like I own the brand. My brand is Hubert Young.

What can you say about the food industry in the Philippines?

As far as the food industry is concerned, it is still a growing market. Filipinos' disposable income is increasing. The population is big, and there is a good chance of more growth. We have already hit the high-end market, the B market, and, now with Mos Burger, the upper C and B markets. Moving forward, we want the Filipinos to appreciate the real, authentic and affordable quality of Japanese food.

How would you describe your management style?

My being hands-on is enabling the people who work with me to think how I think so they can do the hands-on while I look at the bigger picture and steer our business to future growth.

Where did your interest in Japanese products come from?

It developed through the years of traveling to Japan, my dealings with them, and enjoying my time in Japan. To me, every time I come to Japan, it is a learning day and I discover new little things. Even in convenience stores, I love looking at the trends, what they are doing, who is buying what. I would even buy and try things thinking, how can they be so good with just this price? These are the things that intrigue me.

Business Talk Extended An interview with the top executives of Japanese companies that have penetrated the Philippine market



Keiichi Kuroda was born in Tokyo in 1976. After graduating from Teikyo University, he ventured into music and HR businesses. In 2009, he opened a casual French restaurant in Tokyo. Since 2013, he has worked in the Philippines and opened a ramen restaurant.

Keiichi Kuroda is currently the CEO of Ramen Kuroda, a Japanese restaurant that has been attracting a huge amount of attention worldwide as a representative example of Japanese cuisine. The restaurant is known for offering Japanese-quality ramen at reasonable prices. Directly managing all the shops, Kuroda brings to the table his vast career experience, which includes human resources and even

Could you tell us about your business in the Philippines?

We started providing genuine ramen in 2013 in BF Homes, Parañaque and now have 18 branches in the Philippines. Thanks to our loyal customers, the sales of the first branch keeps growing until now. I did my own business in Singapore around that time. Seeing the growing potential of the Philippine restaurant industry, however, I decided to focus on the business in the Philippines instead of Singapore.

We always offer authentic Japanese ramen at an affordable price: P180 for a bowl of ramen.

Why is your ramen so affordable?

As long as we do business in the Philippines, I would like to offer affordable prices so that ramen can be a part of people's daily lives. Though the Philippines' economy has grown steadily, I thought 400 pesos was way too expensive as the price of a bowl of ramen in the Philippines. To be honest, the prices of our ramen was the advice of my business partner who knows the Philippines very well.

We use chef-selected flour to serve the best noodles, extract umami carefully from pork bone into the soup, and exert ourselves continuously to achieve our mission: "Make ramen part of your every day ". We check the richness of broth three times a day at every store.

Which aspects of the business are you focused on?

I'm always at a hiring interview in the Philippines. As a whole, the work environment of a dining establishment is not good, such as hiring conditions. Therefore, I would like to offer a good environment where people have a lot of opportunities. We have an original work system that increases employee salary and there is no salary limit for managers.

How did you go on your career path before coming to the Philippines?

I was in a music-related business and opened a casual French restaurant in Japan before. In my high school days, there was a big movement of hip hop so I wanted to be a DJ. When I was a college student, I worked as a DJ on weekends. After I graduated from college, I and my DJ friend started a business related to music. We got investment from venture capitals.

However, the business went bad so I started to do another business related to HR with my current business partner, which didn't work well because of the bankruptcy of Lehman Brothers. Then, finally, I ventured into food business in Japan.

Why did you get into that industry?

I used to be interested in food business during my DJ times. Owing to a famous French chef, I opened my casual French restaurant in Nerima district, Tokyo when I was 32 years old. One of my customers then told me that he had a property for rent, and I saw an opportunity for a ramen restaurant because there were Japanese pubs nearby.

How did you start your ramen business?

I needed to know about ramen, so we visited a famous ramen restaurant, Menya Isshi in Fukuoka, Japan. We happened to meet the owner, and we were able to set up a shop with their expertise-we opened "Nerima Isshi." That was my real beginning. I really appreciate the support from the people who surrounded me.

What other plans do you have for the foreseeable future?

I would like to open 24 branches in the Philippines by 2020. Moreover, I want to expand our business in other countries in Southeast Asia and Europe with our Filipino staff. Our mission is, "Take a chance and aggressively challenge. Keeping up to the point of origin, we change step by step."

What is your motto?

"Talent is the ability to sustain passion."

I learned this phrase from the TV and later learned that it was the quote from Hayao Miyazaki, a Japanese animator, a filmmaker and co-founder of Studio Ghibli.




