That's why we asked Mr. Terada of Tokyo Grand Renovation, an interior design expert, to share with us renovation tips and tricks!

# Tips for better ambiance for your personal space

# Improve the aesthetics of your private space

Carpets and rugs give your interior the ambiance of a luxury hotel. Install it across your floor if you want to give it some sort of majestic vibe. You can buy a 2m x 2m

carpet on Lazada for around P1000-2000. Once installed, you'll immediately see the difference.

# If you manipulate your home's lighting, the atmosphere will change and improve!

Putting table lamps in a room and lighting them in a low position will cast shadows on the ceiling. It will dramatically improve the mood of your interior due to the illumination created by the intermingling lights and shadows.



# Improving toilet lighting

For bathrooms, either make the room very bright with a high-wattage LED light, or use dim lights to create a more calming atmosphere. If you use a clear LED light bulb, it will cast a clean and sharp shadow. Use this type of lighting if you want to create a more sharp ambience. But in the end, you can choose whatever lighting that suits your taste and preference.



### Tips when decorating narrow interiors

Pick the right furniture for the right space. Many people choose furniture based on their appearance first, but their size is the most important factor, practically speaking. If you get small furniture, you can maximize your spaces and make your home stylish, as well as functional.

### Movable furniture are the best

# LET'S GROW SOME HOUSEPLANTS

To those living in the Philippines, which has a warm climate all year round, this is a great opportunity to grow houseplants! By adding some to your home, it turns into an amazing living space. In this article, we are featuring plants that will thrive in the climate here in the Philippines and where to buy them. In addition, we are also showcasing frequently used items for this increasingly popular hobby.



# Recommended plants to grow in the Philippines

We listed down low-maintenance plants for beginners. Their common English names are also included for easy reference when you look for them in a shop.



### Dracaena reflexa

Common English names: Song of India, Song of Jamaica The Song of India grows long, bright green and yellow leaves. It grows fast and is durable, which is perfect for beginners. However, the tips of the leaves tend to wither due to fluorine in the water and dry air. Fortunately, the plant itself will live even if its leaves wither.



### Syngonium podophyllum Common English names: Arrowhead Plant, Arrowhead Vine, Goosefoot

The goosefoot has arrowhead-shaped leaves with beautiful patterns. It's a creeping vine perfect in a hanging pot. Do not ingest its leaves as they contain poison like pothos. Keep this plant out of reach of children and pets.



### Tillandsia Common English names: Air Plant, Sky Plant, Tillandsia A unique plant that grows without roots. Since it does not require soil to arow, it gives people the freedom to be creative with their Air Plant displays. The plants enjoy bright light, and can rot from too much watering. Various species of Air Plants are available in

### Epipremnum aureum Common English names: Golden pothos, Devil's Ivy

It produces shiny green and yellow mottled leaves. A popular houseplant because it is easy to grow even in indoors. It's a creeping vine shape suitable for hanging pots. New plants can be grown from cuttings. Its leaves are poisonous so don't let small children or pets ingest them.

# Sansevieria trifasciata Common English names: Mother-in-law's tongue, Snake plant

A succulent with hard, thick leaves that thrives in dry soil. It has long leaves with straight yellow edges, that can grow up to a meter. It is a very durable plant, so it is recommended for beginners.

Monstera deliciosa Common English names: Monstera

A large plant with notched leaves larger than the palm of the hand. It has aerial roots that absorb water and nutrients in the air that also support it when climbing surfaces.

# **Essentials To Keep Your Plants Look Prettier**

## Shelf rack

If you are using small pots, we recommend installing a wall-mounted shelf rack because it doesn't eat up much floor space. Meanwhile, the double-sided shelf is a versatile shelf that can be used as a room divider or a wall or corner decoration



### Pot Covers

Let's replant and choose a ceramic pot that is more stylish compared to a regular plastic pot that is generally sold. If replanting is difficult, a pot cover is recommended. There

are various materials and designs for pot covers such as rattan, hand-woven folk crafts. and wood to choose from, so it's fun to find the one that suits your plant.



## Hydroton clay pebbles

Hydroton clay pebbles are a kind of an alternative growing medium used instead of soil. Since you

don't have to use a pot with a hole in the bottom, you can try planting small plants in a mug, and choose a container in which you will grow your plant.



## Stand

Invest in a good stand. It will help you to see and appreciate more the beauty of the plants because you're giving them enough height and space to grow. If you use stands of varying height, the plants will have a three-dimensional effect and will look organized and beautiful.

# Ornamental stones/sand

You may use ornamental stones and sand as decorations. These can be found at your nearest plant shop's supply sections. You can also use stones from fish tanks that are usually sold in pet stores.
